**Selection Process for Ph.D. and M.S.(R) programmes**

The criteria for shortlisting of full-time, part-time and full-time sponsored applicants for Ph.D. and M.S.(R) programmes can be found at the [webpage](#) of Department of Mechanical Engineering.

The call letters for written test will reach shortlisted applicants through email by May 11, 2018. Applicants who does not satisfy the shortlisting requirement yet receive a communication inviting for the written test/interview are requested to ignore such an email. For others, please contact the undersigned in case of any discrepancy or if the email is not received by the given date.

All shortlisted candidates for admission to full-time/part-time Ph.D. and M.S.(R) programmes of Department of Mechanical Engineering, IIT Delhi will have to appear for a written test and interview according to the following schedule.

The written test will be from the GATE syllabus of Mechanical Engineering. Applicants will have to appear in an exam corresponding to only one choice of the specializations: (a) Design, (b) Thermofluids, (c) Production, and (d) Industrial engineering. Only applicants shortlisted based on the written test performance will be eligible to appear for the interview.

As per Student Affairs Section, candidates coming for Test/Interview will be provided accommodation in the Hostels on sharing basis on payment of Rs. 400/- per day (lodging & boarding). Please note that for boys the hostel that has been allotted for accommodation is Jwalamukhi and for girls it is Kailash. The Payment shall be made by way of **Demand Draft** drawn in favor of “**Deans Discretionary Fund, IIT Delhi ....(hostel name) Hostel**”. Please note that bedding is not provided and candidates are requested to make their own arrangement.

Candidates eligible for Full-time with assistantship are entitled to reimbursement of Travelling Allowance for the journey made in connection with the interview by 2<sup>nd</sup> class Rail Fare by the shortest route. For this, applicants will need to bring the following particulars:

- a) Name as in bank account
- b) Name of bank
- c) Branch Address
- d) Bank Account Number
- e) IFSCCode of bank
- f) Mobile Number

These details will have to be filled in a TA/DA claim form at the time of the written test/interview. Full-time applicants are also requested to bring a cancelled cheque to avail reimbursement.
